

ORDINANCE #31

REGULATION OF SIZE AND HORSEPOWER OF INBOARD AND OUTBOARD MOTORS
ON TROUT LAKE

The Town Board of the Town of Bolton ordain and enact as follows:

SECTION 1

No person shall operate on the waters of Trout Lake in the Town of Bolton within 1500 feet of shore, a mechanically propelled vessel which is propelled by a motor which has a manufacturer's rating of more than 50 horsepower.

(a) This ordinance shall not apply to a vessel propelled by a motor exceeding a manufacturer's rating of 50 horsepower, which vessel and motor prior to July 1, 1976 were on the waters of Trout Lake and provided further that the owner of such vessel and motor, upon appropriate notice from the Town, registers the motor and vessel with the Town Clerk prior to October 1, 1976. Such registration shall be made by delivery to the Town Clerk a written statement specifying the name of the owner, the New York State registration number of the vessel and the name of the manufacturer of motor and the rated horsepower of the motor, and a statement that such vessel and motor has been used for more than 30 days on the waters of Trout Lake. In the event such vessel and motor is transferred by such owner after registration with the Town Clerk the transferee shall not be exempt from this ordinance.

SECTION 2

A violation of this ordinance shall be an offense and any person violating the same may upon conviction be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100 or by imprisonment not exceeding 15 days or by both said fine and imprisonment

SECTION 3

This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1976
